



BASIC CERTIFICATE COURSE IN PALLIATIVE MEDICINE

A six-week intensive training programme
in palliative care for doctors

This is a course run by the WHO Demonstration Project in Calicut, Kerala, South India. The course is suitable for doctors with an interest or some previous experience in palliative care.

Palliative care is a growing specialty in India. Few centres devote all their time to patients with incurable diseases. There are no training programmes in South East Asia with an emphasis on clinical skills.

The training programme:

- Provides hands-on training in symptom management and communication skills.
- Introduces trainees to a range of methods of palliative care delivery, as out patients, inpatients, homecare, and in community link centres.
- Includes lectures by specialists in the field, assignments, presentations and project preparation followed by an overall assessment.
- Candidates maintain a logbook during the course.
- Evaluation

Course fee is Rs 15,000 (Rupees fifteen thousand only) appx \$350. Few seats are available at subsidized fee of Rs:5000.

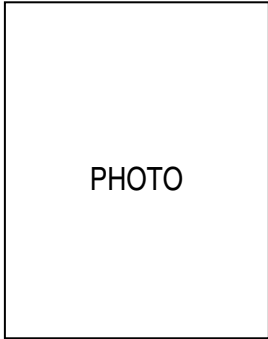
For doctors from India a subsidized course fee is Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only). Basic accommodation at a subsidized rate will be available at the Institute of Palliative Medicine. The candidates have to inform us sufficiently early to avail this facility.
